

## Exhibition Home Game Process

This pertains to **ALL NON-LEAGUE GAMES ONLY**. Please follow the below process for all exhibition games:

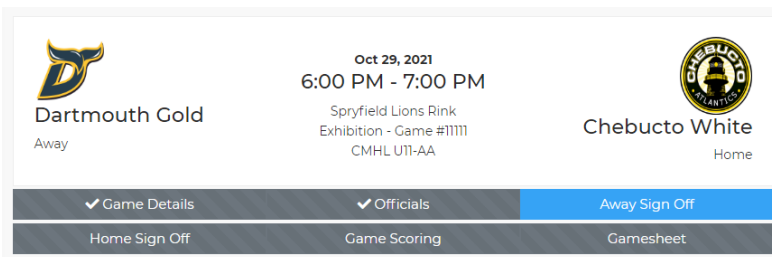
1. Request exhibition game permit. [CLICK HERE](#) for the “How to “ instructions to request travel and exhibition game permits  
\*\*PLEASE NOTE below for when to request what type of permit:  
- **Exhibition game** permits are to be requested when hosting games outside of regular season  
- **Travel permits** are for Tournaments and when travelling to an exhibition game being hosted by another MHA
2. Once permit is requested, Home team is to then forward the email to the below listed people with all game details and to request the game be created in GrayJay and to book officials for game **(TEAMS ARE NOT CREATE THE GAME IN GRAYJAY)**

3. Beth / Pat will create the games in Grayjay and confirm back to team it’s been created.
4. Once game is created, Pete Boutin will assign Officials and Timekeeper. Once officials are assigned and the assignments are accepted, if you look at the game in Grayjay, Officials will show a check mark by them



5. Please ensure to have correct payment amount for officials in cash and in an envelope for each official and timekeeper. They are to be paid before the game begins. Teams should never be adding any games in system under Games - Regular Season OR Games – Exhibition, these should be done by someone with League Admin Access, like Pat, Beth or Pete. If you need to enter a game for a team that is not in your league, like a tournament game, go to Team events, add an event and choose Tournament Game for Event Type. These games are with teams not in the system and that would require a Paper Game sheet .
